International Award in First Aid at Work and the Use of an AED

1.1 Overview

This qualification is accredited and recognised internationally and has been developed by Highfield, the UK and Middle East's leading supplier of security and compliance-based qualifications The Highfield Level 3 International Award in First Aid at Work and the Use of an AED is a qualification aimed at providing candidates with the necessary knowledge, understanding and skills to support first aid and the safe use of a defibrillator in the workplace. This qualification has been developed to protect customers, staff, brand reputation and profits.

1.2 How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

This qualification is usually obtained by taking a 3-day (18 hours) classroom-based course with the ratio of 1 qualified tutor to 8 learners in any one instance

1.3 How is the qualification assessed?

This qualification is assessed by two methods:

- practical observation and,
- centre marked multiple choice theory assessment. This theory assessment will be via a series of multiple-choice
 questions, which can be a written assessment or conducted orally by the assessor.

1.4 How is the course delivered?

The First Aid program provide participants with;

- a good theoretical basis from which to approach medical emergencies and allow participants to apply this
 knowledge through practical exercises and group work and includes treatment for; external bleeding and
 hypovolemic shock, fractures, dislocations, sprains and strains, head, chest and spinal injuries and recognising
 major illness.
- A number of tutor to learner demonstration designed to allow participants apply the concepts presented will be
 applied throughout delivery to ensure learning has taken place and includes; assessing an incident, patient
 primary and secondary assessment (DRABC), partial or complete blockage/obstruction of the airway, effective
 CPR and use of Automatic External Defibrillator (AED).
